HUNTING, TRAPPING, SNARING AND FIREARMS DISCHARGE BY-LAW 2014-006

Whereas the municipality wishes to modify the existing by-law 207;

Whereas the municipality wishes to implement a by-law in regards to the discharging of firearms, hunting, trapping and snaring within the municipal jurisdiction;

Whereas the municipality deems it necessary to adopt such a by-law in the best interest and safety of its general public;

Whereas a notice of motion was given by Joe Belanger at a regular council meeting held on April 7 2014;

Therefore;

It is moved by Donald Graveline and unanimously resolved at a regular council meeting held on May, 2014 to adopt By-law 2014-006 modifying by-law .

Article 1 PROHIBITED ACTIONS

It is forbidden to discharge firearms , bows or cross-bows within 20 meters from the center of any municipal road;

It is forbidden to hunt, trap and snare on roads, property, fence lines or ditches within municipal jurisdiction without written authorization;

Article 2 PENAL PROVISIONS

Any person found in contradiction of this By-Law 2014-006 will be fined by the municipality in the amount 500\$ for each offense and will be reported to federal or provincial regulated bodies pursuant to law enforcement ;

Article 3

This present by-law 2014-006 abrogates and replaces the by-law 207.

Article 4

The present by-law 2014-006 will come into force according to the law.
